We invite all Shark swimmers to be a part of the World's Largest Swim Lesson...with a chance to break the Guinness World Record for # of simultaneous swim lessons.

The event is being run throughout the world. Last year's record is set at 3,971 participants. The estimate is that 30,000 will participate this year in support of drowning awareness. – smashing the WR!!!

Regular Practice is cancelled. We want the following age groups to show up at the following pools

Spicewood Pool = 6U and 7-8 age groups plus Waterloo Participants

Balcones Pool = 9-10 and up age groups

Need everyone to show up at 9am to register at your designated pool

Each swimmer and volunteer will sign in to be counted towards the event #s

At 9:45 the Head Instructor will place each participant with their swim instructor

At 10am, the swim lesson will begin (throughout the world!!!)

The lesson will end at 10:45am

The lesson will be followed by a World Record certificate being passed out to every participant
