

BCC Sharks 2010 Division III Meet Information

Teams: BCC Sharks vs. Wells Branch Armada vs. Block House Creek Tidal Waves

Host team/pool: Wells Branch (see map on Sharks website)

Meet start time: 7:45 am

Sharks Meet Set-up – Arrival at pool: 5:30 am

Shark Swimmers Arrival Time:

Due to the large number of swimmers at a Divisional Meet the swimmer arrival time, swimmer check in time and warm-up time is staggered. Please be on time for check-in!

Target arriving in the vicinity of the pool about 10-15 minutes before the check-in time to allow for drop off/parking because there will be a lot of traffic!

- 8 & under 6:15 am check in
- 9/10 6:30 am check in
- 11/12 6:45 am check in
- 13 & up 7:00 am check in

Parent volunteers: Arrive no later than your swimmer's check-in times. BCC will be set up in area closest to the parking lot. The volunteer assignments for this meet will be in three parts. Be sure to check with your Volunteer Coordinator for any position / assignment changes.

Parking/Drop-off: Due to the high volume of traffic, it might be best to drop off swimmers and one parent – then go and park car. Allow for plenty of time to get settled in – swimmers to their tents – parents to their volunteer position. The traffic and parking will take some time, but Wells Branch is prepared to direct traffic and keep things flowing.

Results: Parents, please review the meet results as they are posted (by the pool main entrance) and notify Brian Gimarc or Denise Raper (our meet directors) if you find an error or question a time or a DQ. It is important that we resolve any issues as quickly as possible to be sure the correct swimmers are awarded their medals and ribbons and high point is correct. We also want to be sure that anyone qualifying for the Invitational meet is credited properly.

Meet Length: The meet will be longer than a normal dual swim meet – make sure your swimmers get plenty of food, drink and rest. Be on time and remember this meet is for Divisional Championship!

Concessions: Wells Branch will have expanded concessions with a large variety of food for sale. *Papa Murphy's Pizza – grilled fresh on-site - Roasted Corn - Pulled Pork Sandwiches – smoked overnight - Breakfast Tacos - Round Rock Donuts - Hamburgers - Cheeseburgers - Hot Dogs - Sausage wraps – Nachos – Chips Homemade muffins – from scratch - Candy – Sodas – Gatorade – Water – Coffee - Kona Ice – snow cones*

Awards: There will be a break after the results of all the 6 & Under events are in to award high point trophies to those swimmers. If you have a 6 & Under swimmer in contention, be sure and stick around. The rest of the high point trophies and team championship trophy will be awarded at the end of the meet as soon as the results are final. Expect some delay between the meet conclusion and the awards.

Divisional Meet Scoring and Awards

The Divisional meet is scored differently than a regular dual meet since there are 3 teams competing. The following is a summary of scoring and awards.

Individual Events

Medals are given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and ribbons are given for 4th through 12th. Points are scored through 8th place.

1st - 9 points

2nd - 7 points

3rd - 6 points

4th - 5 points

5th - 4 points

6th - 3 points

7th - 2 points

8th - 1 point

Relay Events

Medals are given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and ribbons are given for 4th through 8th. Points are scored through 8th place.

1st - 9 points

2nd - 7 points

3rd - 6 points

4th - 5 points

5th - 4 points

6th - 3 points

7th - 2 points

8th - 1 points

High Point Trophies

High point trophies are given to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place swimmer in each age group. It's based on total points earned during individual events and can be from any of the 3 teams.

Team Championship Trophy

The team that scores the most overall points wins the Division III Team Championship trophy.
